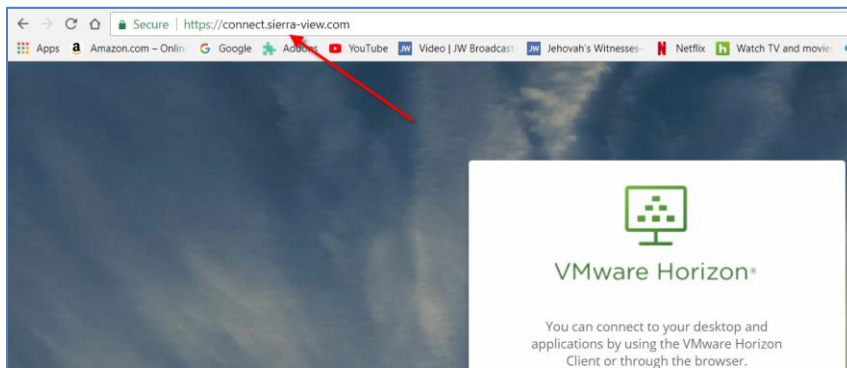
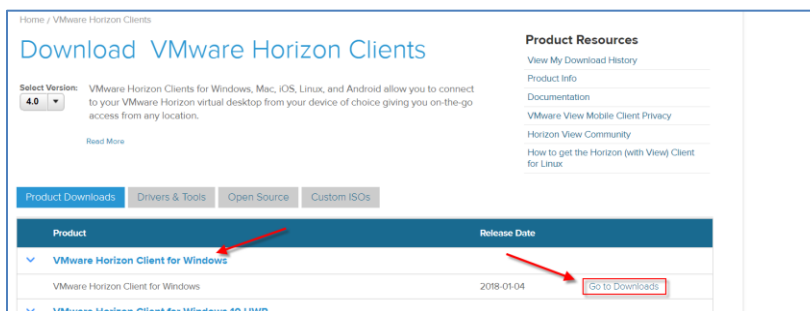


Installing/Updating VMware Horizon for Remote Access to SVMC

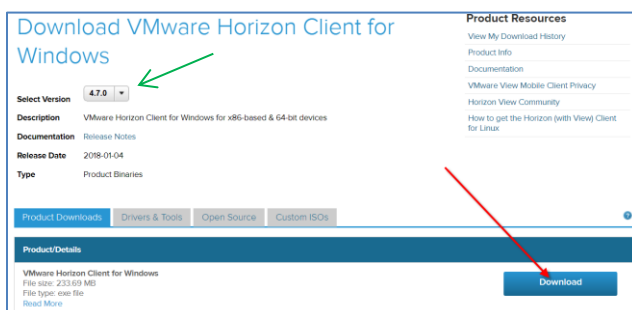
For both a new install and updating to the newest client for the VMware Horizon client, you first need to browse to <https://connect.sierra-view.com>. Then select the **“Install VMware Horizon Client”** link.



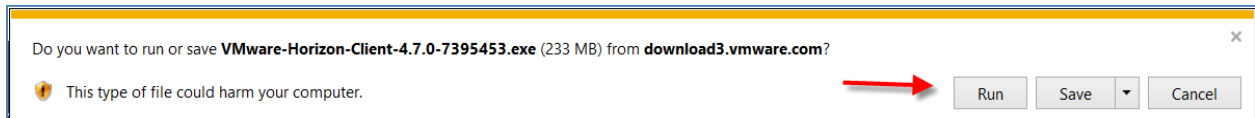
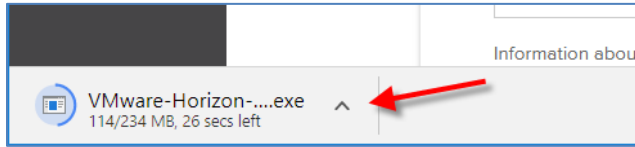
Next you will see the client download page. Select the **correct install for your operating system**. For most Windows PC's it is the first install at the top. Now click on the **“Go to Downloads”** link.



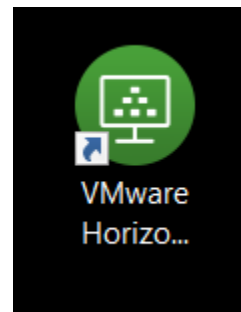
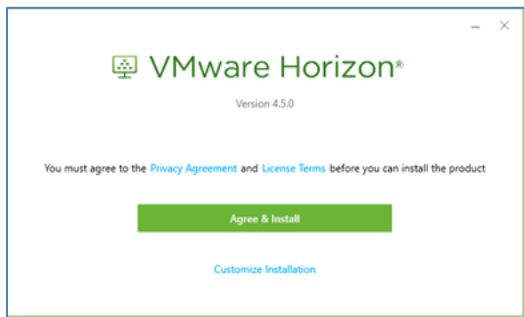
Now from the download page, click the **“Download”** button. If you have issues installing, change **version to 4.5**.



The file will now download. Depending on what browser you are on, the download may look different. Below are a couple of examples. Once the download is complete, run it.



Agree to the license terms and wait for the install to finish. When asked to reboot, you can select to do so later. You should now have a new green icon on the desktop. Launch the icon.



When the Horizon Client opens you may see a cloud icon with an old server name (desktop.sierra-view.com) under it. If so, right click on it and select remove. Once there is no server name listed, you need to add the correct Server Name. Select the "New Server" option and type in "connect.sierra-view.com" as the name of the server, and click "Connect". The log in screen should appear. You can click "Cancel" and you should now see the Cloud Icon with the correct Server Name under it. Clicking it will now give you access to the SVMC Information Systems. Questions, call 559-788-6090
