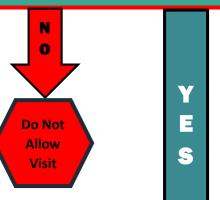
Proof of vaccination

- COVID-19 vaccination record card
- Photo of vaccination record card
- Documentation of COVID-19 vaccination from a health care provider

Po Not Allow

Visit

Proof of negative SARS-CoV-2 test COLLECTED within 72 hours before each visit



With history of COVID-19 within the prior 90 days

See back for exemptions

Documentation of recovery from COVID-19 and release from isolation

Y E S Do Not Allow Visit

Give visitor surgical mask and allow visit



Visitation Guidelines After passing COVID-19 screening:

Exemptions:

- 1. Visitors who are visiting a patient in critical condition, when death may be imminent.
- 2. In emergent situations
- **3.** Parent or guardian visitors of pediatric patients
- **4.** Person visiting for bonding visits including in-room stay with a newborn and hospitalized parent
- **5.** Support persons for a patient with physical, intellectual, developmental disability or cognitive impairments are *only required to pass the initial COVID-19 screening*

These visitors must comply with the vaccine verification or applicable testing requirements as soon as reasonably possible, but no longer than 72 hours

Definitions:

Fully vaccinated: Individuals whose **second** COVID-19 vaccine dose (or single dose if Janssen vaccine) was given at least 2 weeks ago.

Incompletely vaccinated: Individual who has received **1** of 2 COVID-19 vaccine doses (Pfizer/Moderna)

Unvaccinated: Individuals who have not received any doses of COVID-19 vaccine.

Hospitalized parent: Parent who is admitted due to childbirth
