Electives taken in PGY-2 year may be from any available rotations, but will focus on preferentially scheduling Gastroenterology (1 month), Endocrinology (1 month), and Hematology-Oncology (1 month) Electives will vary in location from inpatient to outpatient (private office) depending on the elective. The 10% outpatient component of the Wards and ICU months reflects ongoing Continuity Clinic.

The Primary Care Clinic month will tentatively be held in the Internal Medicine Resident Continuity Clinic, under the direction of the precepting attending. Should the patient volume not be sufficient, it may be relocated to an outpatient private office of an Internal Medicine teaching faculty member.

The remaining 2 electives may be taken in 2 week blocks; the resident may choose from experiences in Allergy-Immunology, Medical ophthalmology, Otorhinolaryngology, Non-Operative Orthopedics, Palliative Medicine, and Sleep Medicine. Electives will vary in location from inpatient to outpatient (private office) depending on the elective. The 10% outpatient component of the Wards and ICU months reflects ongoing Continuity Clinic.
