GUIDELINES FOR MEETING ATTENDEES/GUESTS

Sierra View Medical Center is committed to keeping our community safe from Covid-19 during this time of a high transmission within our community. However, we would also like to provide a way for our community to attend the open session of the Board of Director's Meeting. As a result, our Infection Prevention Department has provided rule (based on CDC guidelines) for safely attending the meeting on July 26th.

In order to attend the meeting as a guest or as a member of the media, the following guidelines must be followed:

- 1. Upon arrival at the Main Entrance, **check in** with the staff at the front desk and let them know that you are here to attend the open session of the Board of Director's Meeting
- 2. State if you are a representative of the media
- 3. You will be asked to **participate in a Covid-19 Screening** which will include taking your temperature and answering a few questions
- 4. Once you pass the Covid-19 screening, you will be given a green sticker that allows you to attend only the open session of Board of Director's Meeting
- 5. You must **wear a well-fitting mask**, regardless of vaccination status, that covers your nose and your chin and you must keep it on while at SVMC
- 6. Once you enter the conference room, you must **maintain social distancing** (at least 6 feet apart) and you may not remove your mask.
- 7. Do not move chairs as they have been placed specifically for social distancing
- 8. Use hand sanitizer or wash your hands often
- 9. Everyone is required to adhere to the Covid-19 guidelines while attending the open session
